**StoryBook Festival at Southwest Regional Library on November 18**

**BROWARD COUNTY, FL** – Children and their families are invited to a magical world of stories at the Broward County Library’s StoryBook Festival from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. on November 18 at the Southwest Regional Library, 16835 Sheridan Street in Pembroke Pines.

The free festival will feature performances on two stages, fairy-tale crafts, strolling storybook characters and the Miami Herald’s Fantasy Forest, where children can interact with fairy-tale friends. The first 1,500 children at the festival will receive a free book. Performances will include: *The Frog Prince* by Puppets to Go, *High School Musical Revue* by Superstar Productions; international storytellers Kuniko Yamamoto (Japan), Marie-Monique Jean-Gilles (Haiti), and Zien (Colombia); the Geddy the Gecko Reading Show; Salty Sue’s Pirate Lore; and *Songs & Stories of the Sea* by Tom and Chris Kastle.

The library event is being held in conjunction with Children’s Book Week, which is November 13 -19.

The StoryBook Festival is funded through the Broward Public Library Foundation with support from *The Miami Herald*, the City of Pembroke Pines, *Broward Family Magazine* and Friends of Southwest Regional Library.
