Broward County Commission Libraries Division Announces
New Downloadable Books and Audio Books

BROWARD COUNTY, FL – Broward County Library now offers a great new service that allows customers to download eBooks and Audio books to their personal recording devices such as a MP3 player, view via Adobe® Reader®, or burn to a CD. Additionally, customers can listen to their favorite book via Windows Media Player while they are using their computer.

The **OverDrive eCollection** is a free digital service available to all Broward County Library card holders.

A Quick Start Guide is available to give customers an overview of the service and instructions to download the free software. Customers will need to have Internet access and their library card to download and install the software.

Broward County Library currently offers a large selection with hundreds of titles that range from self-help books to the classics.

In the left navigational bar, customers can browse all eBooks and Audio Books or select by format or subject. Staff recommendations and recent searches, excerpts as well as reviews and information about the author are also available for each title.

To access this new service, visit www.broward.org/library and click on the Free Online Resources link in the right navigational bar. Select E-Books and Audio Books then choose **OverDrive**.
