**BROWARD COUNTY, FL** – Broward County Library's E-Newsletter received a MarCom Creative Award which recognizes outstanding achievement by marketing and communication professionals. Over 5,000 entries from the United States and internationally were received for the 2006 MarCom Creative Award.

Broward County Library's E-Newsletter began in November 2004 with a text-based format and a small amount of subscribers. In the past two years, it has transformed into an interactive media format with almost 4,000 monthly subscribers.

The E-Newsletter has been recognized with numerous accolades including awards from PR News, National Association of Government Communicators and National Association of County Information Officers.
