**Broward County Commission Libraries Division Announces  
West Regional Library to Close to Move to New Library**

**BROWARD COUNTY, FL** – Broward County Library will close its **West Regional Library** located at 8601 West Broward Boulevard in Plantation at 5 p.m. on Sunday, January 7, 2007 and remain closed to the public until the new library opens in an adjacent location.

The building will be demolished in order to complete the library site for the **new West Regional Library**. While the library is closed, customers can visit other Broward County Library locations or visit Broward County Library's website, [www.broward.org/library](http://www.broward.org/library), to find materials in the catalog, place holds with their choice of pick-up at any Broward County Library, renew selected materials and much more. Traveling Library service will also be available on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 10:30 a.m. to noon starting January 9 in the parking lot area of the West Regional Library. Customers are asked to let the library staff know where they would like to pick up their holds while **West Regional** is inaccessible.
