**Novelist Susan Isaacs to Speak on May 7, 2006**

**BROWARD COUNTY, FL** – Novelist Susan Isaacs, author of *Any Place I Hang My Hat*, will be speaking at an afternoon tea on Sunday, May 7, 2006 at 2 p.m. at the Katz Building, 5890 South Pine Island Road (northeast corner of Pine Island Road and Stirling Road), Davie, on the campus of the David Posnack Jewish Community Center. The Broward Public Library Foundation and the Broward Region of Hadassah are sharing this program that promotes reading and introduces participants to the benefits of both groups.

Ms. Isaacs will be discussing her many novels, including the release in paperback of her 10<sup>th</sup> hardcover book, *Any Place I Hang My Hat*. This latest work deals with the psychological fallout from a classic Isaacs' family situation of a daughter who parents her parents. Her first novel, *Compromising Positions*, became a bestseller and was made into a movie in 1985 starring Susan Sarandon and Raul Julia. Borders will be selling Ms. Isaacs books that afternoon. Ms. Isaacs will sign her books following the tea.
